

Adjusted Air change : 5731 CFM 50



Energy Audit Test Out <u>Air Leakage</u>

- Prior to renovation CFM50:5731
- Post Renovation CFM50: 1718
 Reduction of 70%

Energy Audit Test Out Heating Savings

•167 MMBTUS

• 15 Tons of CO₂

Energy use reduced by over 48%

Energy Retrofit Costs

•\$22,435.

• Eff. Vt. Rebate **\$2000**

Costs after Rebate \$20,435

Payback

After rebate costs \$20,425

Estimated Annual Savings
 \$3,217

 Payback in years < 6.5; Less as energy prices rise
