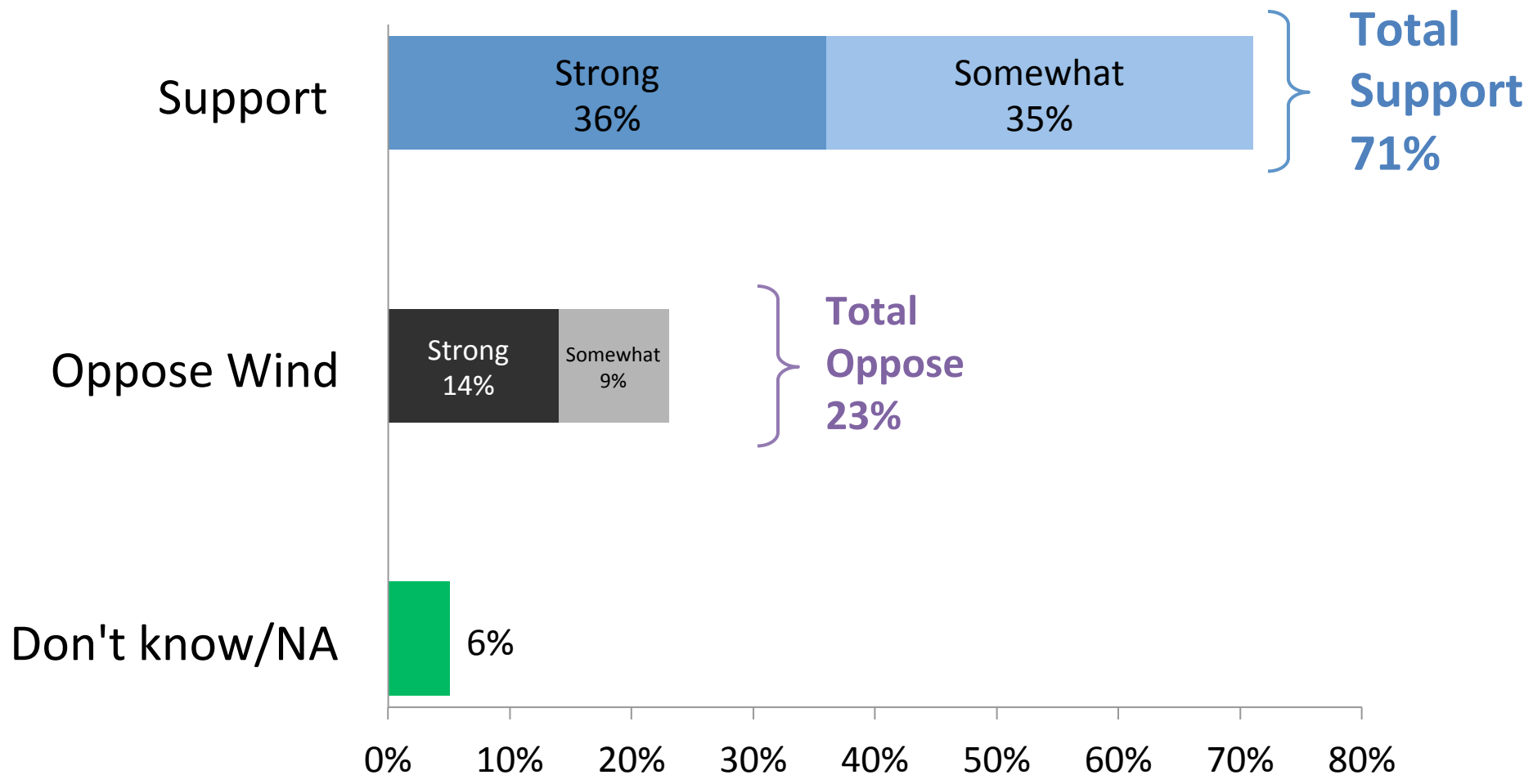


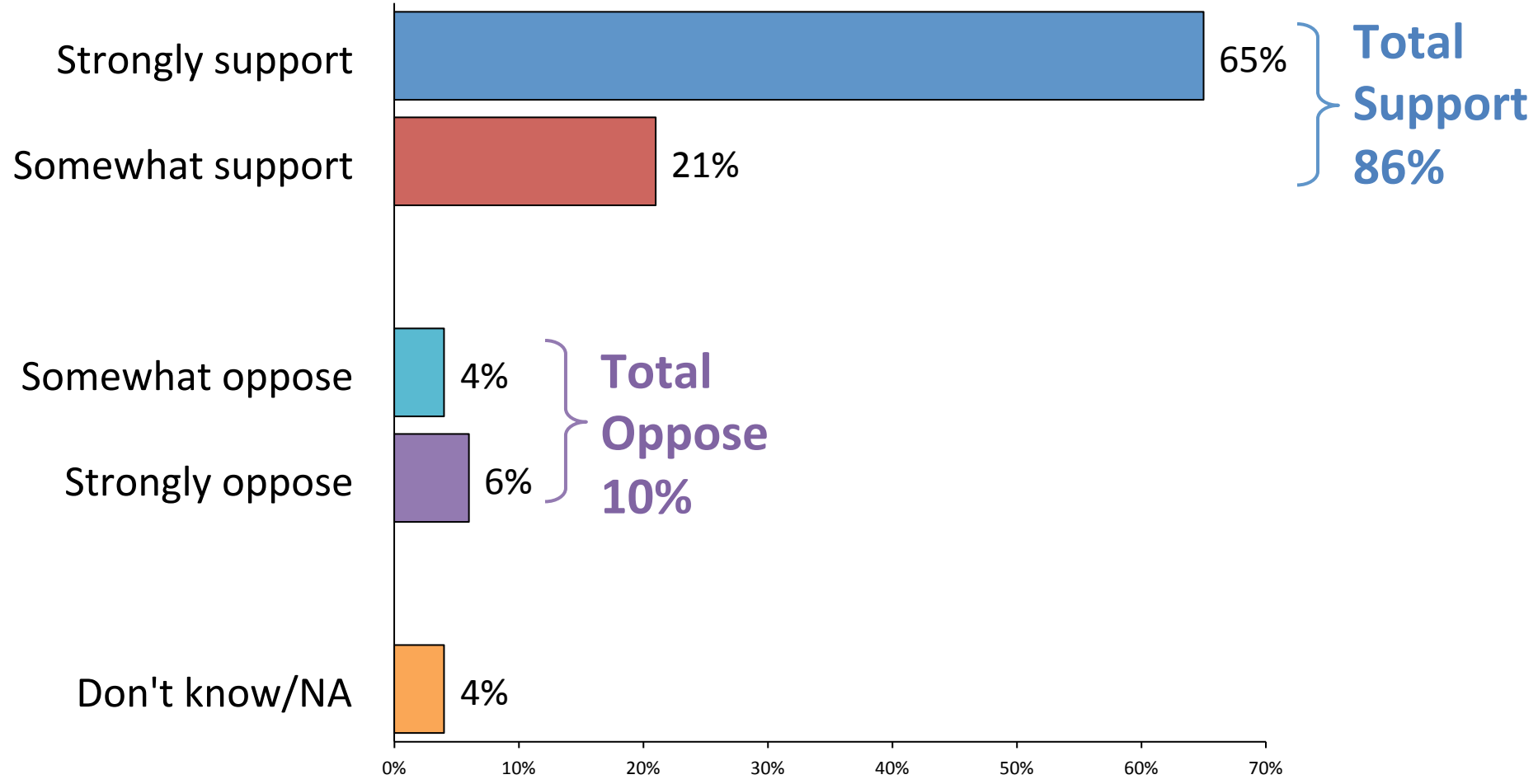
An overwhelming majority of Vermonters continue to support wind energy on ridgelines.

Do you support or oppose building wind energy turbines along the state's ridgelines?



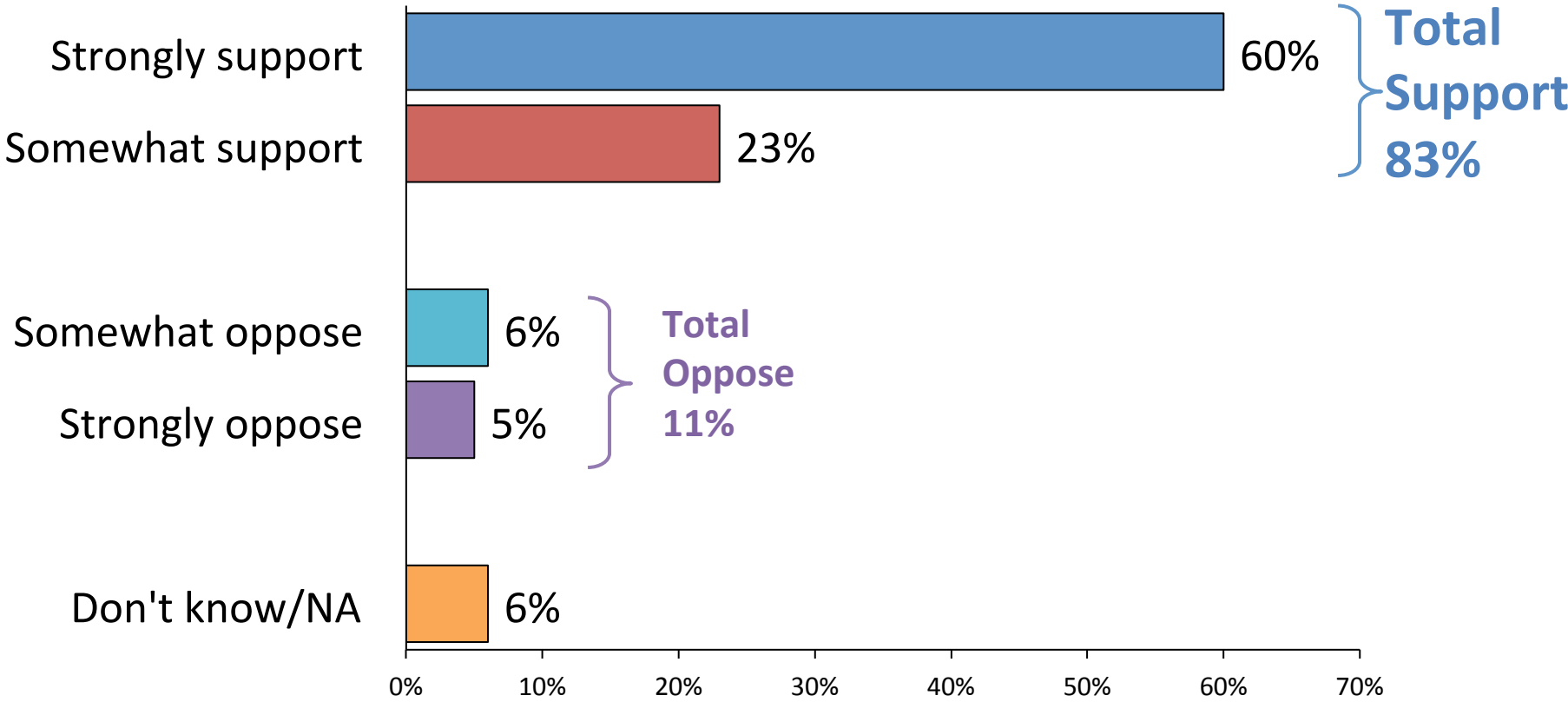
Vermonters broadly and deeply support the state's goal of getting 90 percent of our energy from renewable sources by 2050.

Support for the state's clean energy goal is anything but hypothetical—an overwhelming majority of Vermonters **STRONGLY SUPPORT ACTING NOW**.

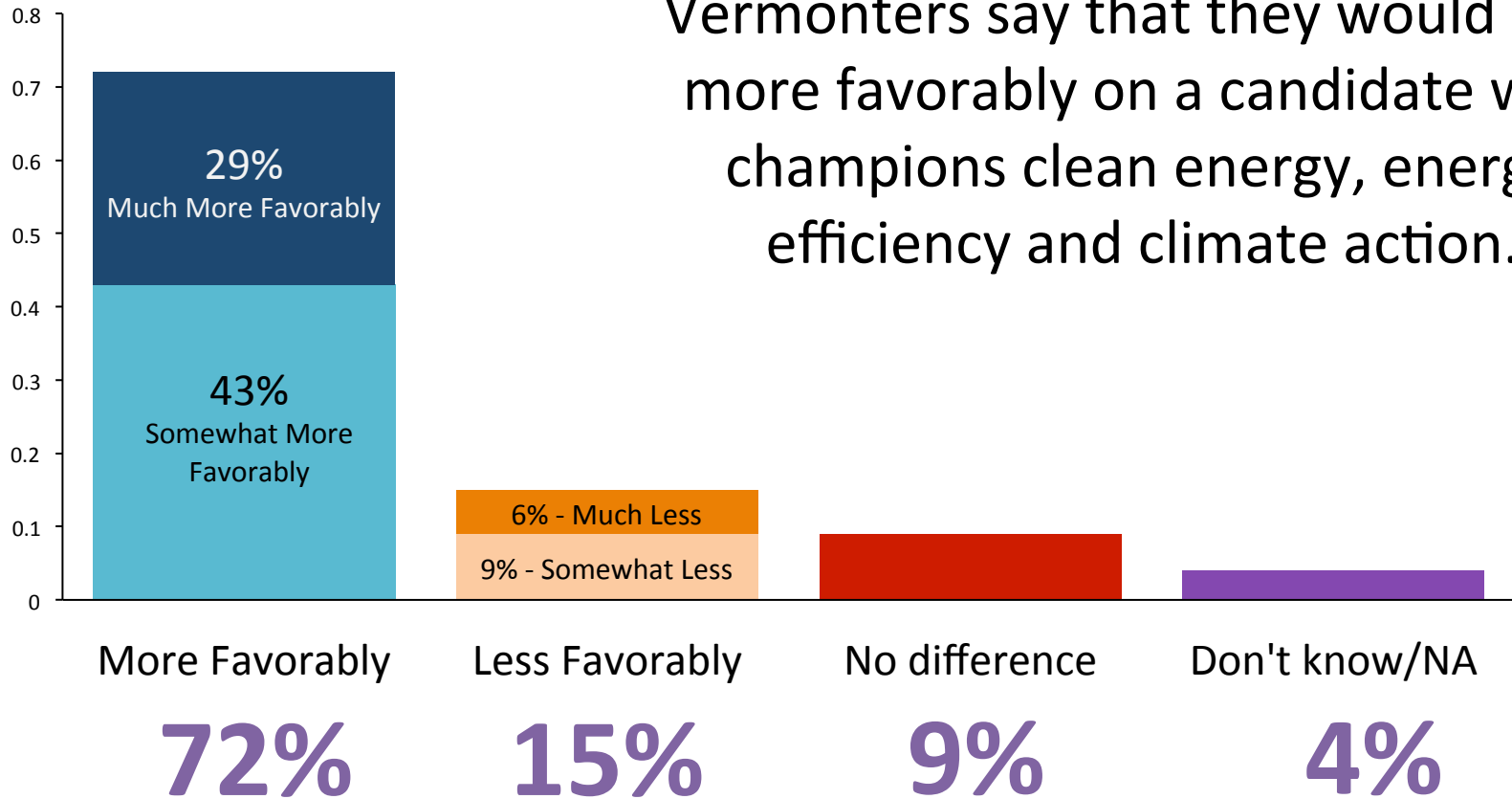
Vermont has a goal of getting 90% of its energy from renewable sources by the year 2050.

CANDIDATES TAKE NOTE

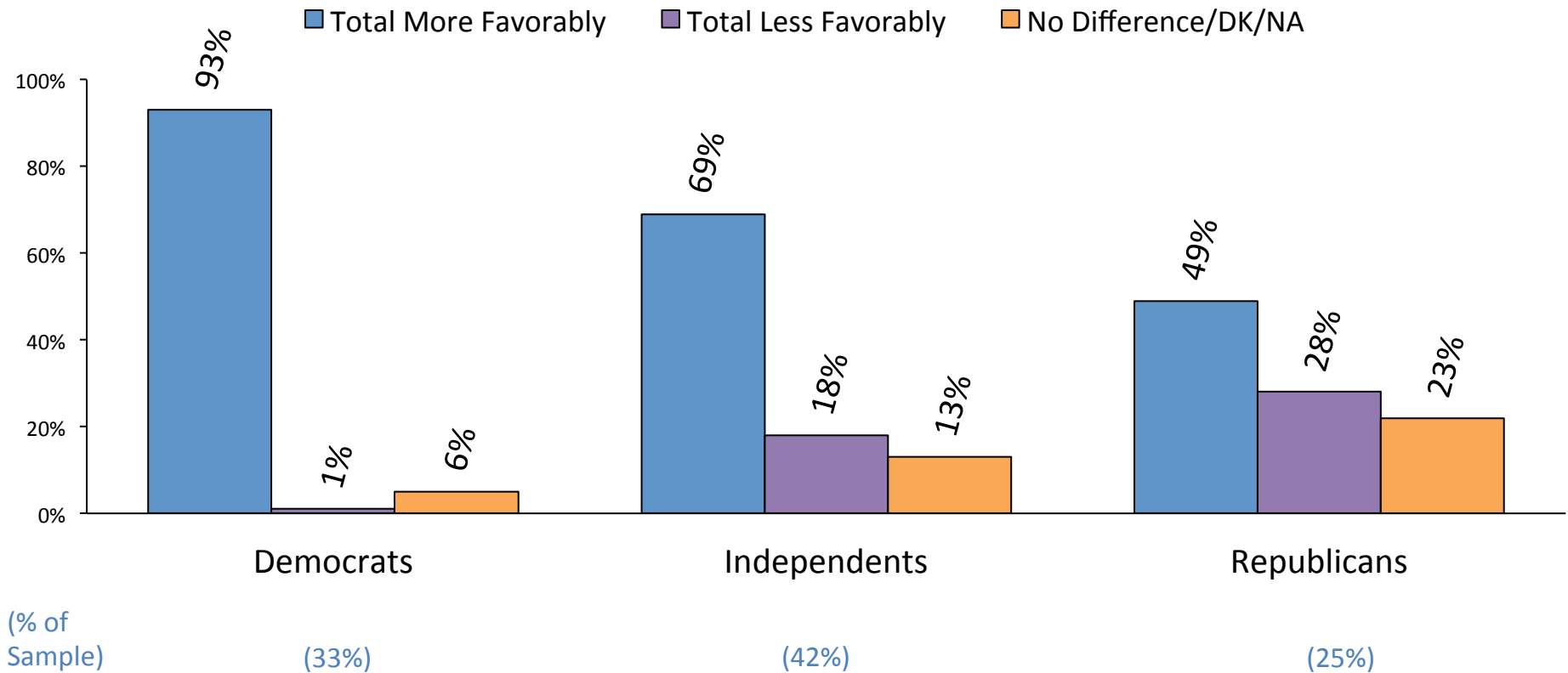
Close to three-quarters of Vermonters say that they would look more favorably on a candidate who champions clean energy, energy efficiency and climate action.
